\$18.00/hour; Alexis Landis \$18.00/hour; Matt Helkenn \$18.00/hour; Savanna Nilles \$18.00/hour; **Lifeguards** – Kami Gerken \$14.00/hour; John Sandbeck \$14.00/hour. Storm seconded the motion. Roll call vote –ayes: Gruis, Hamilton, Storm and Vivian, –nays: none, – abstain: Gerken. Motion carried.

John Grotluschen requested the closure of Main St (between Michigan and Minnesota) and Michigan Ave (between Sidney St and Virginia St) for the HWY 339 Show and Shine Car Show to be held on September 8, 2024. Gerken made a motion to allow the street closure. Storm seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

After due consideration and discussion, Gruis introduced and moved the adoption of the **Resolution No. 2024-04-425** next hereinafter set out, the same being a resolution approving an executed contract and performance and/or payment bonds for the Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project. The motion was seconded by Vivian and passed. Roll call vote: –ayes: Gerken, Gruis, Hamilton, Storm and Vivian, –nays: none. Motion carried.

Council received one sealed bid for the 1984 Dump Truck. Mayor Sprock opened and read the bid out loud to the council. The council agreed to accept the bid from Mike Petitt. Vivian introduced the following **Resolution No. 2024-04-426** entitled "RESOLUTION AWARDING 1984 INTERNATIONAL SINGLE AXEL DUMP TRUCK" and moved that the same be adopted. Gruis seconded the motion to adopt. Roll call vote: –ayes: Gerken, Gruis, Hamilton, Storm and Vivian, –nays: none. Motion carried.

Gruis made a motion to appoint Jim McConnell to serve a 3-year term and Tim DeBruin and Joe Quincey to serve a 4-year term on the Planning & Zoning/Board of Adjustment. Vivian seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Council discussed the quote to install an isolation valve for a new fire line at the GLR School. Council will table this in search of more information.

Gruis made a motion to accept the bid from Mitchell & Hus Excavation to install manhole on the 600 block of E Michigan Ave using ARPA funding for the project. Vivian seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Gruis made a motion to approve the Alcohol & Liquor License for Last Call 2. Gerken seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Next monthly council meeting will be held May 8, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.

Vivian made a motion to adjourn at 8:24 pm. Gerken seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.
